

Inkjets vs Inktanks

InkJETS have a built in print head and circuitry that is susceptible to damage. These typically go in printers that take 1 black and 1 all-in-one color cartridge.

InkTANKS do not have a built in print head though they may have a small chip on them. They are merely a light hollow tank when empty with no real circuitry or electronic look to them. With tanks there is typically one cartridge per color and go in printers that take up to 6 individual color cartridges at a time.

Inkjets have circuitry and a print head.
